THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST

Lesson 1

It is NOT “Revelations” – it is singular “Revelation”. Neither is it the Revelation of St. John the Divine. Rather, it is the “revelation” of Jesus Christ. It is both His Revelation *to us* of coming events, but also God’s revelation *of Himself* to us.

The book was probably written sometime after 90 AD by John, the apostle, when he was exiled on the Island of Patmos. He is the same John who wrote the Gospel of John and I, II and III John. He is the brother of James, and one of the three inner circle disciples who were with Jesus on the Mount of Transfiguration. He was the beloved disciple whom Jesus entrusted with the care of His mother.

I. FOUR VIEWS OF REVELATION

1. Preterist – The view that the book was fulfilled under Nero and Domitian
2. Historical – The view that the book was fulfilled down through the years of church history
3. Idealist or Spiritualizing – The view that it is all to be spiritualized and is not literal
4. Futurist – The view that the book is prophetic and from the fourth chapter onward it deals with the last days. In this view, Chapters 6-18 contain a blow-by-blow description of the Great Tribulation.

II. THREE MAIN HERMENEUTICAL VIEWS OF THE ENDTIMES

1. A-millennial
”A” means “no”. Those holding this view usually hold the preterist or idealist interpretation and do not believe there will be a millennium.
2. Post-millennial
These believe the church will set up the kingdom and Jesus will return after (post) the millennium.

3. Pre-millennial

These believe Jesus will come back before the millennium and He will set up His kingdom. Pre-millennialists usually interpret the Bible literally. This is the view of most of the early church fathers.

III. THOSE WHO ARE NOT PRE-MILLENNIALISTS HOLD THREE DIFFERENT VIEWS CONCERNING THE GREAT TRIBULATION.

1. Pre-trib return of Jesus Christ

Jesus will rapture out the church before the tribulation begins and He will return to earth to set up His kingdom at the end of the tribulation. This is the view of the writers of the Left Behind series. This is the view espoused by the notes in the Scofield and Dakes study Bibles.

2. Mid-trib return of Christ

The seven year tribulation is divided into two 3 ½ year periods. Christ will rapture the church out in the middle of the tribulation and return to set up His kingdom 3 ½ years later at the end of the tribulation.

3. Post-trib return of Christ

The church will go through the tribulation and Jesus will return at the end of the seven years. The church will be caught up to meet Him and return immediately to earth with Him.

IV. TWO EXTREMES TO AVOID

1. Ignoring the book because it is a mystery and cannot be understood. There are mysteries in the Bible, but this book is a “revelation”. The word “revelation” is “apocalypse” – a revealing; a making known.
2. It is the only book worthy of studying.

V. A REVELATION SIGNIFIED (verses 1, 2)

1. Revelation – unveiling – uncovering – a manifestation of Jesus Christ
Jesus came to earth veiled in flesh. On the Mount of Transfiguration, Peter, James and John got a glimpse of Him in glory. In this book, we will see Him revealed (unveiled).
2. Signified = sign-i-fied or given in signs and symbols.
3. It shows things that will shortly come to pass.
4. It was given by an angel. So was the Law.
5. It was given to John to give to us.

6. John bore record of three things (verse 2):

- i. The Word of God
- ii. The testimony of Jesus Christ
- iii. All things he saw

VI. THE PROMISE TO READERS (verse 3)

1. Blessed are the readers, the hearers, and the keepers of (those who practice) this book.
2. It is called a prophecy.
3. A warning is given in Revelation 22:18-19 concerning adding to or taking from the book.

VII. THE TIME IS AT HAND (verse 3)

1. It always is.
2. He may return at daybreak, noon or midnight
3. *“One day is with the Lord as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day.”*
(2 Peter 3:8)
4. We are creatures of time. He is eternal.

5. We are not date setters.
Jesus said, “No man knows the day nor the hour.”
He said, “It is not for you to know.”
He said, “When you see these things coming to pass, you know it is near.”
He said, “Watch and pray.”

THE SEVEN CHURCHES OF ASIA – Part 1
Lesson 3

The seven churches were **real** churches located in Asia Minor – now the country of Turkey. There was a message relevant to each church.

Seven is the perfect number. The seven represented all churches. We can apply the truths spoken to those seven to any church at any time.

There were usually seven parts to each letter. In one or two cases, not all the features apply.

I. THE COMMISSION – “To the angel of the church at . . . write . . .”

1. Angel (Gr. Angelos) – means “messenger”
2. The messenger – the pastor – the one giving God’s message to the church
3. Notice where the messenger is – in Jesus’ right hand.

II. THE CHARACTER – “These things saith He . . .” followed by a description of Jesus found in Chapter 1

1. He is described differently to each church
2. He is to us what we need and more.
3. To the lost – a savior
To the sick – a healer
To the weak – the Holy Ghost baptizer

III. THE COMMENDATION – “I know thy works . . .”

1. Encouraging – If no one else knows our good deeds, Jesus does.
2. Sobering – He also knows our bad deeds.
3. Jesus commended most of the churches.

IV. THE CONDEMNATION – “But I have against thee . . .”

1. He knows our weaknesses.
2. He speaks the truth in love.

V. THE CORRECTION – Usually given as a command, not a suggestion.

1. This gives hope.
2. Shows He has not given up on us.

VI. THE CALL – “He that hath an ear, let him hear . . .” (uniform in every letter except in the last four letters it takes seventh place rather than sixth in the order)

1. Churches are made up of people.
2. Individuals have to hear and respond to His call.

VII. THE CHALLENGE – “To him that overcometh . . .”

1. Each letter has a promise to the overcomers.
2. The promises are great.

I. EPHESUS – The Church Which Left Its First Love (Rev. 2:1-7)

1. History of the Church – Acts 19
Born in red-hot revival with special miracles, followed by persecution

II. SMYRNA – The Persecuted Church (Rev. 2:8-11)

1. Persecution and martyrdom
2. Told not to fear
3. Promised the crown of life

1. The doctrine of Balaam
2. The doctrine of Nicolaitans
Ephesus rejected the deeds of the Nicolaitans and Pergamos accepted the doctrine of the Nicolaitans.

1. Jezebel operated there.
2. Fornication was the sin.
3. Space to repent

V. SARDIS – The Dead Church (Rev. 3:1-6)

1. It had a name that it was alive.
2. Had some things still alive.
3. Answer: Strengthen the parts still alive.

VI. PHILADELPHIA – The Church of the Open Door (Rev. 3:7-13)

1. Philadelphia – brotherly love
2. God opened the door; no man can close it. (It has opposition, but it will prevail.)

VII. LAODICEA – The Lukewarm Church (Rev. 3:14-21)

1. Lukewarm – will be spewed out

2. “Thou sayest . . . and knowest not”

3. Good advice (verses 18-20)

I. FIRST SEAL – A WHITE HORSE (Rev. 6:1-2)

1. Anti-Christ

2. Counterfeit of the white horse of Revelation 19

3. A ruler who appears good

4. He will appear to be:
 - a. Peaceful
 - b. Have economic answers

 - BUT
 - c. He is deceptive (Matthew 24:4-5)
 - d. Israel will sign a pact with him.
 - e. Jews will think he is the Messiah (John 5:43).

II. THE SECOND SEAL – A RED HORSE (Rev. 6:3-4)

1. Red = bloodshed

2. War (Matthew 24:6-7)
(Power to take peace from the earth)
(Given a sword – nations will arm)

III. THIRD SEAL – A BLACK HORSE (Rev. 6:5-6)

2. Quart for a day's wage
3. The problem will not be making the house payment. The problem will be having food on the table.

V. FIFTH SEAL – SOULS UNDER THE ALTAR (Rev. 6:9-11)

1. Martyrs – they were conscious
2. How long? Time had meaning.
3. Others to be martyred – they were told of happenings on Earth
4. White robes given

VI. SIXTH SEAL – THE DAY OF HIS WRATH (Rev. 6:12-17)

1. A great earthquake
2. Appearance of sun and moon changed
3. Meteors
4. Cosmic shaking
5. People ran to dens and caves
6. They recognized it as the great day of God's wrath.
7. Question: "Who shall be able to stand?"

After this, we see a parenthesis chapter (Revelation 7).

1. God warns.
2. He sends first wave of judgment.
3. He delays.

5. God sends stronger judgment.

**SEVEN ANGELS AND SEVEN TRUMPETS
Revelation 8-10**

Lesson 9

When the Seventh Seal was opened all Heaven went silent (verse 1). The inhabitants of heaven were struck dumb and stood in silent awe when they saw what was about to happen on earth.

Seven angels with seven trumpets stood before God – very ominous – judgment is about to fall.

But then John saw another angel (vs. 3-5). We see the power of the prayer of the saints to delay judgment. We also see another round of warning before judgment begins.

Verse 6 – No mention of repentance. So the angels prepare to sound.

- I. FIRST TRUMPET (verse 7)– Judgment destructive of plants, trees and grass (v. 7)**

- II. SECOND TRUMPET (verse 8) – Judgment destroys 1/3 of sea life. The great mountain could be an asteroid crashing into the ocean.**

- III. THIRD TRUMPET (verse 10) – Loss of human life**

- IV. FOURTH TRUMPET (verses 12-13) – Sun and moon affected.
The three woes announced. This is just warming up for what comes next.**

- V. FIFTH TRUMPET (9:1-12)
The First Woe – Demonic Invasion**

- VI. SIXTH TRUMPET (9:13-21)
The Second Woe – Invasion of 200,000,000 man army from the East**

VII. THE DELAY BEFORE THE SEVENTH TRUMPET

1. This angel (messenger) might be Christ Himself (10:1-7)
--no longer delay
--In the days of the seventh trumpet, the mystery of God is completed.

2. John told to eat the Book (10:8-11)

3. He measured the temple (11:1)

4. The time of tribulation = 42 months (11:2)

5. The two witnesses (11:2-13)

6. The second woe is past (11:14)
